Library 2014 Budget Submission

4.3 Library 2014 Budget Submission

The Library Director reviewed the draft Library 2014–2018 Five Year Financial Plan Submission with trustees. It was highlighted that the library's provincial per capita operating grant is likely to be reduced (from \$2.50 per capita to \$1.79 per capita) as early as 2015. The funding formula is linked to a population threshold; when a City's population reaches 35,000 the lower per capita rate is automatically applied. Projected impact on the library's operating budget is an annual revenue decrease of \$24,000.

THAT the Library Board write a letter to Mayor and Council informing them that a reduction in the provincial per capita library operating grant is anticipated as soon as 2015 and that, hence, the Library Board will likely be submitting a deficit operating budget from 2015 onwards.

THAT the Library Board's 2014-2018 Five Year Financial Plan submission show an operating budget deficit of \$24,000 from 2015 onwards linked to the anticipated reduction in provincial per capita library operating grant.
